

Directions to The Olde Rectory

From The Wheatsheaf on the main A44, drive up the steep hill into the village centre, continuing straight ahead and down a steep hill as if you were leaving the village.

Directly in front of you at the bottom of the hill is a large house sideways on to the road with a walled garden and some rather cheeky looking garden cherubs. As you reach this point you will see a sign to The Olde Rectory immediately in front of you on the garden wall and a 'no through road' sign to your right leading to Whitbourne village church.

Turn right towards the Church and take the **second** driveway on your left (the one with the Hungarian Fighting Cart at its entrance!). Parking is in the main car park at the top of the drive to the right but there is an unloading area to the left directly in front of the properties. We would respectfully request that your car is moved to the main car park after unloading. Please report to the front door of The Olde Rectory upon your arrival and we will take you to your accommodation, assist with your luggage and explain everything you will need to know.

For guests staying in Tedney Lodge

Please come to The Rectory to collect your keys and wherever possible, we will escort you to Tedney and show you around. Should this not be possible for any reason, to locate Tedney Lodge, go back to junction at Whitbourne village church and turn right staying on lower lane. Continue straight ahead for about 1 mile (it may seem longer in dark!!) until you reach a crossroads over a small bridge. Turn right immediately **before** the bridge, signposted **Tedney no through lane**. Tedney Lodge is the first property you can see on your left and is about 150 metres up this narrow lane.
